


- This is a suggested residential programme over 2 days with us.

VISIT TO CENACOLO COMMUNITY

Cenacolo is a community in Knock for young men recovering from addictions, who are overcoming their difficulties through sharing in a community of faith. These young people share their stories with us, and explain how they live and work together. They also explain how faith is an important part of their recovery.

CLIMB CROAGH PATRICK

Croagh Patrick is located just outside the beautiful town of Westport. It was on the summit of this mountain that St. Patrick fasted for 40 days in 441AD, you can join the many pilgrims that visit Ireland's holiest mountain to undertake the three hour pilgrimage climb.

This climb can be tough but students can gain a real sense of achievement on reaching the top and it is a wonderful experience of pilgrimage.

The Youth Ministry Team can provide you with simple reflections and prayers that you may want to use on the climb.
