Remembering the Apparition Witnesses Mrs. Margaret Byrne 1814 – 1909

Monday 4 March marks the 110th anniversary of the death of Mrs. Margaret Byrne, widow of Dominick, who was the second eldest of the Knock witnesses. On the evening of the Apparition, Margaret (nee Bourke) had just returned from the seaside village of Lecanvey with her daughter Maggie. She lived with her family in a thatched house on the east side of the Parish Church, which later became known as 'The Thatch'. It is from this house that Margaret, her daughters Maggie and Mary, her son Dominick and granddaughter Catherine Murray rushed out to see the Apparition. Margaret is buried in Knock old graveyard and will be remembered at 9am Mass on the day. May she rest in peace.

Patrick Walsh 1814 – 1889

Tuesday 5 March marks the 130th anniversary of the death of Patrick Walsh, Apparition Witness. Patrick lived about half a mile from the village on the Ballyhaunis road in the townland of Carrownamallaght, known locally as Ballinderris. On the evening of the Apparition, Patrick was going through his land gathering up tools after a day's haymaking when he saw what he described as 'a large globe of golden light' around the gable of Knock Church. Patrick is buried in Knock old graveyard and will be remembered at 9am Mass on the day. May he rest in peace.
