



The Beehive Meditation Cell was created by renowned sculptor Imogen Stuart in 1990. Irish monks and hermits lived in these cells on the Skelligs and elsewhere from the sixth century onwards. Sitting in the cell you can feel the peace of God's presence.



The Beehive Cell is open daily for visitors to experience in the Chapel of Reconciliation from 11am-4pm (winter) and 11am-5pm (summer).
