This Cell is an interactive work of art. You may enter when the door is open. Close the door, and turn the three-minute timer. Relax and experience the welcoming atmosphere and the silence. Allow yourself to become peaceful. Think of the monks of old who spent many hours daily in communion with God in cells like this one.

The Beehive Meditation Cell was created by renowned sculptor Imogen Stuart in 1990. Irish monks and hermits lived in these cells on the Skelligs and elsewhere from the sixth century onward. Sitting in the cell you can feel the peace of God's presence.


