PARTICIPANTS CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

Knock Shrine seeks to proclaim the Kingdom of God and to make known the Good News of Christ more fully through worship, service and witness. In keeping with this aim, ministry with children and young people in Knock is informed by the three principals of truth, justice and love.

Knock recognises the dignity and rights of all children and young people and is committed to ensuring the safety and wellbeing in a way that promotes their human dignity, integrity and worth as children of God.

Knock recognises that all who work with children and young people have a special duty of care towards them. Leaders must create a safe environment for children and young people in order to secure their protection and enable full participation in the life of the church. Knock has committed itself to putting procedures in place to ensure the welfare and protection of children and young people together with the welfare of those who work with them. The welfare of the child is always paramount.

It is essential that all young people taking part in the volunteer programme adhere to the code of behaviour at all times.

- 1. The taking of un-prescribed medication, drugs or alcohol on the pilgrimage is absolutely forbidden. Smoking is also forbidden.
- 2. At all times only females are allowed in the female sleeping areas and only males are allowed in the male sleeping areas. Under no circumstances are participants to entertain a member of the opposite sex in their room/ sleeping quarters.
- 3. No -one has permission to be outside the sleeping area after curfew except in the company of the appointed leaders. After curfew everyone is obliged to be in their own bed in their own room.
- 4. Participants are not allowed to leave the Knock Shrine grounds at any time without a leader or permission to do so.
- 5. The group leaders are there to ensure the safety and protection of all participants on the programme. They must be respected and listened to at all times.
- 6. Participants are to keep to the timetable to facilitate the achievement of the objectives of the weekend. They will participate actively, fully and in cheerful spirits to the best of their ability in the entire programme of events. Each participant will try their best to make the volunteer programme a success for all.
- 7. To ensure that we can properly look after the young people who volunteer with us you are obliged to inform us if they suffer from any physical or emotional ailment which may affect them during their time here. (All information will be treated with the strictest of confidence)
- 8. Participants must take full responsibility for any valuables/money etc. they bring with them
- 9. Participants must always act responsibly, remembering we have a responsibility for the safety of the people in our care.
- 10. We will make every effort so that participants are sharing a room/ sleeping area with the person of their choice, however this may not always be possible. In this case we ask participants to accept the room they are assigned to.
- 11. Each person treats everyone with courtesy and respect.
- 12. Bullying will not be tolerated, and the leaders of the volunteer programme has a very strict anti-bullying policy.
- 13. Participants are not allowed to use or be on their phone or any devices throughout the day unless in an emergency
- 14. You may contact Knock Youth Ministry at any time throughout the weekends on 0876927850
- 15. Participants will be asked to provide an email and mobile phone number for communication. These details will only be used by the leaders for programme related activities. Texts and emails may be used to promote Knock Youth Ministry events. If you are unhappy with this please inform Knock Youth Ministry.
