'SAVE KNOCK COMMUNITY CENTRE - UPDATE ON FUNDRAISING'

"The Community Centre committee, are writing with an update on our recent fundraising appeal for donations towards the refurbishment of Knock Community Centre.

Since our flyers were distributed in March and April, a total of €15,350 has been raised from 51 households in the Knock area. We are extremely grateful to each and every one of you who contributed and we thank you sincerely for your support and your good wishes. For those who have already donated, please disregard this letter. There are approximately 800 households in the Knock area, and with only 51 donating, unfortunately we are falling short in support from the wider community.

As anticipated, due to increases in building costs and inflation, we now find ourselves with a major shortfall in funds as our tender price has come in at €482,500. That's just to do the basics... electricals, plumbing, new windows, fire doors, insulation, etc. Our grant is €300,000 with matched funds of €29,404 required to back it. The shortfall is over €152,000 and with €15,350 raised so far, that total amount required now stands at €136,650. If we can't raise this amount as a community, the project unfortunately can't proceed and Knock Community Centre will be permanently closed. The stringent funding guidelines don't allow for a phased approach, we must have a usable Centre at the end. There is now a great sense of urgency as the completion deadline of January 2024 is fast approaching. If we can secure as much as possible of the €136,650 in donations or pledges, we will apply for a bridging loan, appoint a contractor and work can begin. For those who wish to pay in instalments, e.g. €5 per week or €20 per month, a standing order form is available at Knock Post Office. It would be heart-breaking to fall at the last hurdle, having come this far, and with all the voluntary hours the committee have put in in making the application, appointing an engineer, getting planning permission and countless tender documents drawn up. We really need the support of the whole community in order to progress with the refurbishment plan and bring this project to fruition."
