Remembering the Apparition Witnesses

Tuesday, 09 October marks the anniversary of the death of Patrick Hill. Patrick, who was from Claremorris, was one of the younger witnesses to the Apparition. He was in Knock with his relatives, the Byrnes, helping to bring turf home from the bog on 21 August 1879. He ran to the church that evening from his grandaunt's house with Dominick Byrne, John Curry and John Durkan. Having lifted little John Curry up in his arms, the two boys then crossed the wall and moved into the chapel yard to get a closer look at the Apparition. Patrick later emigrated to the USA and passed away in Massachusetts in 1921. **He will be remembered at 9.00 am Mass on the day.**
